The Marquette Legal Initiative for Nonprofit Corporations (“M-LINC”) is now accepting applications for the 2010-2011 Marquette Strategic Analysis.

One Wisconsin nonprofit organization will be selected to receive:

- **FREE Comprehensive Strategic Analysis**
- **FREE Review of Bylaws and Legal Documents**
- **FREE Governance Evaluation**

If selected for participation, members of the nonprofit's staff and board of directors will meet regularly over the 2010-11 academic year with M-LINC's director and law student volunteers to address the nonprofit's legal and governance issues.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- the nonprofit must be a 501(c)(3) organization with a determination letter from the IRS;*
- the nonprofit must be unable to pay for legal services without impairment of its programs;*
- the nonprofit must have a specific project that requires strategic and legal analysis; and*
- the nonprofit must be organized and operated in Wisconsin.*

Required documentation includes the following:

- a brief description of the nonprofit, including its mission, current goals, program activities, staff size, and use of volunteers;*
- a comprehensive description of the project or challenge confronting the organization, including a delineation of the legal and strategic issues needing analysis, and the steps already taken to address this project or challenge; and*
- any other information you may deem helpful to the M-LINC advisory council in its selection decision.*
